CONTEST RULES

- **ONLY ENTRIES RECEIVED BETWEEN JUNE 15, 2026 AND AUGUST 15, 2026, 12 MIDNIGHT PDT WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- **Submit all entries via email to ask@snowleopardconservancy.org.**

Note: Entries submitted through social media/messaging/texting will not be accepted.

- Artwork and Poetry previously submitted to Snow Leopard Conservancy Contests in part or in whole **WILL NOT** be considered.
- No employee, subcontractor, associate, partner, or representative of the Snow Leopard Conservancy may submit entries to the contest.
- **Amateur and professional artists and writers** are invited to submit entries.
- **You may submit up to two (2) entries; 1 work of art and 1 poem.**
- There is no fee to enter, and no monetary prizes are awarded.

DIVISIONS

Original Poetry

Original Traditional Artwork

For example, Oils, Acrylics, Pastels, Charcoal, Pencil, Colored Pencils, Pen, Marker, Crayon, Watercolors, or Scratchboard

Original Digital Artwork

Original Combined Media – A Combination of Traditional & Digital Artwork

Original Unique Media – For example, woodworking, needlework, clay, collages, concrete work, beading, etc.

- **POETRY ENTRIES** should be submitted as either a **WORD DOCUMENT** or in **PDF** format. Any other file format will be rejected.
- **The electronic file MUST BE LABELED AS FOLLOWS OR WILL BE REJECTED:**
 - **YOUR NAME**
 - **TITLE OF THE ENTRY**
- **ARTWORK ENTRIES** should be submitted electronically (a photo of your original artwork – framed or unframed) in **JPEG** format. Any other file format will be rejected.
- **The electronic file MUST BE LABELED AS FOLLOWS OR WILL BE REJECTED:**
 - **YOUR NAME**
 - **TITLE OF THE ENTRY**
 - Emailed files of artwork are required to be at least 1.5 MB and no larger than 6 MB. Please reduce resolution of your photos larger than 6 MB.
 - If you have used a reference photo for your artwork, you **must provide the photographer's name**.
 - You may include a brief narrative that provides background on your artwork, but it is not required. A narrative is not a substitution for the artwork, itself, exemplifying or expressing the theme.

- **ALL ARTWORK SUBMITTED MUST BE SIGNED OR INITIALED OR YOUR ENTRY WILL BE REJECTED!**

ALL SUBMISSIONS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN EMAIL CONTAINING THE FOLLOWING:

- The artist's/author's name
- Age category you are entering: Adult 18 & Over – Youth 12-17 – Youth 11 & Under
- Division you are entering: Poetry – Traditional Artwork – Digital Artwork – Combined Media Artwork – Unique Media Artwork
- Medium used if Traditional, Combined, or Unique Artwork
- Title of the submission
- Your Email Address

JUDGING CRITERIA

- Interpretation of the contest theme.
 - Portrayal of the beauty & strength of the snow leopard.
 - Creativity, uniqueness, & originality.
 - Overall impression.

- **Finalists in all categories and divisions will be announced Saturday, August 22, 2026, via an online presentation and the Snow Leopard Conservancy's website.**
 - All Finalists will receive a Certificate of Appreciation.
 - **Winners and Honorable Mentions in all categories and divisions will be announced on Saturday, September 5, 2026, via an online presentation and on the Snow Leopard Conservancy's website.**
 - All Winners will receive an Award Certificate

PRIZES

- **Grand Prize and First Place winners in all categories and divisions will be awarded a Unique Symbolic Snow Leopard Adoption Package, which will include special select items from our Online Store.**

- By submitting your artwork and/or poetry, you are giving the Snow Leopard Conservancy permission to display/post it on our website, in newsletters, in our annual impact report, and across our social media channels for the purpose of creating awareness and fundraising. The Snow Leopard Conservancy will not use your poetry or artwork for any other purpose without first obtaining your permission. And any other entity or organization that contacts the Conservancy regarding permission to use your work will be directed to the artist/author.
- Occasionally, the Conservancy will seek additional permission to reproduce the contestant's original artwork in the form of unsigned prints to be offered for sale for the purpose of fundraising through our online store and at special events. In this instance, artists will be contacted individually and are under no obligation to give assent.
- The artist/author will retain the copyright and physical possession of their creations, and any sales of original creations should be conducted between the artist/author and the buyer.
- The Snow Leopard Conservancy will appropriately credit the artwork/poetry to the artist/author, and upon request, will provide contact information for the artist/author. However, the Conservancy is under no obligation to promote professional websites via social media or in any other manner or market submitted creative works.
